Topic: Board Member Nominations

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Any Association Member in good standing is eligible to be nominated for a Board of Directors position.

The appointment of a Nominating Chair, as proposed by the President and approved by the Board of Directors, shall be announced no later than at the October Membership Meeting.

The Nominating Chair should select two other Members to serve on the Nominating Committee.

The Nominating Committee shall do its best to recommend a minimum of two candidates for each applicable office to be announced at the November Membership Meeting.

Members of the Nominating Committee are eligible to be nominated, provided their nomination comes from the floor during the Annual Meeting.

The Presidential candidate(s) shall have the exclusive right to select their running mate.

The Office of President and Vice-President must be voted on and elected as a team.

In all instances, except for that of Vice-President, Members may nominate themselves.
